

The Constitutional Law of Georgia on Amendment to the Constitution of Georgia

Article 1

Paragraph 2 of Article 52 of the Constitution of Georgia (Parliamentary Gazette, 1995, No. 31-33, Art. 668) shall read as follows:

“2. Detention or arrest of a member of the Parliament, or search into his/her residence, car, workplace or personal search shall be made only with the consent of the Parliament, except when the person is caught in the act, which shall be immediately informed to the Parliament. If the Parliament does not provide its consent, the detained or arrest member of the Parliament shall be immediately released.”

Article 2

This law shall enter into force immediately upon promulgation.
